WHY WORKWELL, TX?

In the WorkWell, TX network, all aspects of the claim and care will be handled by Texas Mutual, creating a smoother experience for employers and injured workers. The new network will also offer better control over who provides care, allowing us to select only the best providers with experience in occupational medicine, and proven results. The improved care and outcomes could lead to lower claim costs and a reduced e-mod. Employers who enroll in WorkWell, TX will still receive a 12 percent network discount.

BEGINNING JANUARY 1

The transition to WorkWell, TX will be simple and smooth. Employers will use WorkWell, TX the same way they used the Texas Star Network. The process for reporting injuries will be the same, and the provider directory will still be available online, in the app and by calling Texas Mutual.

A new Notice of Network Requirements will need to be posted, and employees should complete a new Employee Acknowledgment form by December 31, 2018. The form can be completed using a paper copy or through e-Learning.

Any injuries that occurred before January 1, 2018 will still be treated in the Texas Star Network.
